Bergner's Community Days (Fall and Spring)

This is a program offered by Bergner's as a community project. Coupon booklets good for a specific date in November or March are sold for \$5. 100% of the \$5 coupon booklet price for each one sold is kept for the After Prom fundraising.

Booklets are mailed out as part of a mass mailing to the school's population and asked to either return the booklet or \$5 on the honor system. Groups are also allowed to sale different days at Bergner's and keep the \$5 for each booklet sold.

This committee would take care of the mass mailer, collection funds and selling booklets at Bergner's on specific dates. Bergner's offers this program twice a year.

Smoothie King Discount Coupons

This fundraiser program would be responsible for advertising and selling coupons for Smoothie King drinks. The discount coupons would be available for purchase throughout the school year

Monicals Community Days

For 2008-2009:

This is a program offered by Monicals as a community service. Twice a school year a date is selected to be Monical's Community Day. Noodles and Company Community Days

Family, friends, and neighbors visit the selected Noodles and Company location between 4 - 8 pm and Noodles And Company will donate 15% of the sales for that time period. No flier is needed to bring into the restaurant for the donation. The committee would be responsible for advertising and distributing fliers. Krispee Kream Discount Coupons

This fundraiser program would be responsible for advertising and selling 'buy one dozen get one original glazed dozen free' cards. The discount cards would be available for purchase throughout the school year and they have not expiration date. This program could help replace our Subway card from last year since Subway has discontinued their punch card.

Jewel/Osco Shop & Share Program

This program is where fliers are distributed and when they are turned in to the store at the time of check-out Jewel/Osco will give a % of the total sale to the After Prom account. There is no additional cost to the customer only that they bring in the flier. This offer is good at ANY Jewel/Osco not just those located in the local area.
