**Minutes of the Keystone Council Meeting

Chair Mike Sondgeroth called the meeting to order. Members present were Jerry Christenson, Bobbi Wojick, Dixie Lewis, Diane Walker, Suzie Thetard, Gary O'Malley and Jim Kinsella

I. The Minutes were read and approved as corrected

II. Old Business

- **Election Update** After the council had voted to pull Cindy Pulley and Brian Conant from the ballot because of bylaw specifications, Cindy was put back on once her eligibility was confirmed.

Results: Marc Feaster, Peggy Scott, Janice Ives, Tom Holbrook, and Jim Kelly are the newly elected council members.

- **Summer Money** Keystone will participate in the grant program to recommend summer money for assessment work. Diane will chair a subcommittee to review applications and recommend allocation. Suzie, Jim and Dixie will serve on the committee.

May, 23 is the due date for recommendations.

- **Assistant Principal Search** Gary will narrow the applications to 10 and have a search committee compiled of Keystone reps., Department Chair reps., students, and faculty conduct on-site interviews and make a recommendation of 3-4 candidates.
- **John Kilgore** will serve as administrator for summer school

III. New Business

216 Update The need to hold debriefing sessions with instructors was noted. Gary suggested Keystone members and all faculty attend the 5/9 meeting with Dr. Ashby and articulate all 216 concerns. Dixie noted that the IPLP program is

also addressing new standards for clinicals.

Gary noted that Academic Senate has refused to seat Lab School faculty even when representing the College of Ed. It is the wish of the College of Education Administrative Council that faculty associates be recognized and represented in the university governance structure. Dr. O'Malley and Dean Pancrazio agree that we need to be represented. It is important that the faculty let Dr. Ashby know how we stand on this issue.

The meeting adjourned at 12:00.

The next meeting will be a joint meeting of the 2000-2001 and 2001-2002 councils on Friday, 5/25 at 11:00 in the 1857 room.
