

KEYSTONE ELECTIONS FOR 2008-2009

Keystone is now accepting nominations for faculty candidates to fill three vacated positions on the Keystone Council. Nominations will be accepted until Thursday, May 12th at 3:00 pm.

Nominations can be made by the candidate or with the permission of the candidate. Once nominated, the candidate must complete an application which will be on review for all faculty and staff during the week of the election.

The application form is attached to this memo.

In order for the faculty member to be eligible for a position on Keystone, according to the bylaws, they must:

(1) have a continuing faculty contract

AND

(2) be entering at least the third consecutive year of full-time teaching at University High School, or be entering at least the fourth consecutive year of part-time teaching at University High School.
