


## Using Flip Camera with Moviemaker

1. Insert the camera into a usb drive on the computer
2. When prompted, click on “open folder to view files”.
3. Click on “DCIM” and then “100video”.
4. Drag & drop your video file onto the computer desktop.
5. Delete the video from the 100video folder.
6. Disconnect the camera and turn off to save battery (thanks!).

## Open your file in moviemaker

1. From the start menu, open moviemaker
2. Click “import video” and choose your file from the desktop.
3. Movie maker will import your video as multiple clips. You can right click on any of the clips and choose “select all”, then drag it down to the storyboard at the bottom.

## Edit your file in moviemaker

To cut: Drag the slider to where you want the cut to be. Then, click on . Repeat to make other cuts

To re-arrange or delete clips: make your cuts and then drag and move the sections to the correct order on the timeline.

To add video effects, transitions or titles, click on one of these lines; then, drag the effect down to the storyboard/timeline.

## Finish your movie

Before you can play your movie you have to “finish movie”.

1. Click on “save to my computer
2. Type a file name and select your S-drive for the place to save.
3. Choose “other settings” and select “video for broadband, 512” and “next”.
4. After a few minutes your movie will be ready for playback from your s-drive.
