

Directions for setting up your s-drive from home (2008-2009)

Please complete the steps below in order. Once you've set everything up, you should only have to complete the "Connect to ISU" steps each time you want to use your s-drive from home.

One-time install of the VPN client

1. Go to the U-High tech help page and download the "vpn client" from the right-hand column.
2. Choose "Download Cisco VPN client for Windows 2000/XP/Vista" (unless you have a mac).
3. Enter your ISU username and password
4. Click "Run", then "Run", then "Next"
5. Accept the license agreement and click "next" three times
6. Click "finish" and restart your system

Connect to ISU

1. Start the VPN client; go to "start", "programs", "cisco vpn client", and click on "VPN client"
2. Click "connect"
3. Enter your ISU Username and password and "ok"
4. You are now connected to the ISU network.

One-time install of your s-drive

1. You must be connected to the VPN before you can map your drive
2. Right-click on "my computer" and choose "map network drive"
3. Choose the letter "S"
4. For folder, type in one of the following:
 - a. Faculty: <\\uhdata\adilstu\yourusername>
 - b. Freshman: <\\uhdata3\adilstu3\yourusername>
 - c. Sophomores: <\\uhdata2\adilstu4\yourusername>
 - d. Juniors: <\\uhdata2\adilstu5\yourusername>
 - e. Seniors: <\\uhdata3\adilstu2\yourusername>
(replace yourusername with your actual ISU username)
5. Check "reconnect at logon" and click "finish"
